**SCOPE OFWORK:** Acts as State Building Inspector implementing the state building permit inspection program. Evaluates building permits and construction plans. Conducts building and fire code inspections.

### ACCOUNTABILITIES

Assists in the development of professional and technical building and fire safety standards under the direction of the Deputy Fire Marshal and according to departmental guidelines.

Reviews building plans for compliance with state laws and State Building Codes and State Fire Codes relating to the construction of buildings.

Implements the state building permit and inspection program; conducts inspections of all new construction projects in state buildings and others as required in RSA 155-A and Saf-C 8100.

Conducts training programs for building and fire safety personnel related to building safety, fire protection, fire prevention, and fire inspection procedures.

Confers with city and town officials regarding building safety, fire protection and prevention laws, rules, and statutes.

Reviews building and fire inspection reports and makes recommendations for uncorrected hazards, code enforcement, and recommends corrective action as required.

Performs code research and code analysis, makes recommendations, and attends meetings and administrative hearings as necessary.

Inspects buildings and structures to detect hazards and enforces local ordinances and state statutes.

Promotes effective application of State Building and State Fire Codes.
