Purpose

Recipients must be enrolled in a degree or certificate program at a recognized post-secondary education institution, or become enrolled within 6 months of being chosen as a recipient.

- The Scholarship Committee will determine who the recipients are and what the awarded amounts will be. Preference may be given to those individuals enrolled in a program directly related to building construction or building code enforcement.
- Completed applications, including all attachments must be received before **May 31, 2019**.
- Recipients will be determined by the Scholarship Committee by June 20, 2019.
- Recipients shall be announced at a regular association meeting and be notified in July.
- Recipients are encouraged to volunteer at the annual golf tournament.
